## What Time Is King Charles accession ceremony?

It takes place immediately after the death of a monarch, usually the next day. Because the Queen died after 4pm on a Thursday, however, the ceremony took place some 36 hours later, on Saturday at 10AM local time.

**St. James's Palace** - The Accession Council meets in **St. James's Palace** following the death of a monarch and the Accession of a new Sovereign is publicly proclaimed by Garter King of Arms from the Proclamation Gallery overlooking Friary Court.

## What did Charles say about the Queen?

"I speak to you today with feelings of profound sorrow. Throughout her life, Her Majesty The Queen — my beloved Mother — was an inspiration and example to me and to all my family, and we owe her the most heartfelt debt any family can owe to their mother; for her love, affection, guidance, understanding and example."

## Who signs the proclamation of King Charles III?

The Privy Council includes Prince William, who, as the new heir to the throne, was given the title Prince of Wales on Friday by his father. Its other members — **Charles's wife, Camilla, the queen consort; Prime Minister Liz Truss; and senior religious figures** — all signed the proclamation during the ceremony. Notably, not a single person present had been part of the ceremony when Elizabeth was proclaimed sovereign 70 years ago.
